Criteria for application:

- Applicants should also be a member of the ESN at the time of application and still be a member at the time of the congress/symposium (*).
- Applicants should have defended their PhD during the last 6 years at the time of their application
- Bursar recipients are expected to present an oral presentation at the congress/symposium

The ESN Governing Board will select the successful scholars/bursars on the basis of the scientific impact of the research findings and their novelty.
